## Phoenix Convector Range

Introducing the Phoenix Convector Range.

These stylish stoves retain all the features of the Phoenix Range, with the added benefit of reduction in distance to combustibles, typically 100mm to the side and 150mm to the rear.

This is achieved with a 3 sided heatshield encasing the stove.

Convection holes in the top of the stove enable more heat to radiate in to the room.





#### ◀ The Fireblaze 6kW Convector

The largest of the convector range, the Fireblaze 6kW is a stunning contemporary stove. Fully approved for smoke controlled areas. The Fireblaze runs on 127mm flue and is available with integral log store style base.

#### ▲ The Firegem 5kW Convector

A slender stove giving less protrusion into the room. The Firegem convector is approved for smoke controlled areas and is available with the integral log store style base and 127mm flue outlet. As with the other two stoves in the range the Firegem is suitable for a superimposed 12mm hearth.





All stoves are approved for smokeless areas and have an A+ energy rating.

#### ■ The Firewren 4kW Convector

The smallest of the range, suitable for the home, garden rooms, lodges & boats. Shown here on the integral log store style base, giving overall height of 835mm. Fully approved for smokeless areas. The stove runs on a 127mm flue. Features include full riddling multifuel grate and separate ashpan for easy riddling.


